

Origami environmental policy statement

August 2022

Origami is a technology company that provides tools to enable energy market actors to manage the increasing short-term power volatility. As more renewables are added, the volatility will increase and the need for powerful technology is critical.

Origami recognises that, like any business, its activities have an impact on the environment, and we are committed to meeting or exceeding the requirements of all applicable legislative controls and securing continual improvements in environmental performance.

Origami undertakes to continually assess the significance of the environmental impact of its activities and will seek to reduce or eliminate the adverse impact of such activities insofar as practicable.

Origami's ambition is to:

- Champion the transition to a green energy world, powered by smart technology.
- Consider the environmental impact of its supply chain, considering the environmental and social profile of its suppliers and appointing ISO14001-accredited suppliers where appropriate.
- Where applicable and practicable, monitor and strive to minimise the production of any polluting releases into the environment, becoming carbon neutral by July 2022 and offsetting all historic company emissions by the end of July 2023.
- Periodically evaluate its effect on the environment and set ambitious objectives and improvement targets to minimise its environmental impact.
- Promote a strong culture of employee engagement concerning environmental matters throughout the organisation; and
- Encourage other companies and individuals to reduce wasted renewable power, improve the business case for investing in renewable power and to adopt lower carbon heat, power, and transport technologies.

To reduce its impact on the environment, Origami is committed to:

Considering the environmental impact of its business activities, including:

- Reducing food and drink waste and considering more sustainable alternatives, as well as minimising the environmental impact of any waste generated in connection with Origami's office use.

- Measuring and striving to reduce our energy and water usage in connection with our buildings, travel, and technology.
- Wherever practicable, procuring our energy from verified green sources.
- Supporting and promoting green initiatives such as cycle-to-work, electric vehicle use, improved transport links, low carbon heating and power and the adoption of low carbon transport.

Raising the awareness of environmental issues amongst staff, including:

- Promoting the reduced use of single-use items and recycling.
- Minimising the use of resources, such as power and water, both at the workplace and home;
- Promoting the use of low or zero-carbon transport for commuting to work and external meetings where possible, supporting an effective hybrid-working model where practicable and encouraging videoconferencing as an alternative to travel.
- Promoting volunteering opportunities which further environmental sustainability.
